This includes ensuring the effective use of materials, equipment, and personnel in producing quality products at minimum costs. Will be expected to develop, implement and maintain methods, operation sequence and processes in the manufacture and fabrication of parts which will include the estimation of manufacturing costs, time standards and the ability to recommend tooling and process requirements for new and existing products. Will act as a liaison with internal and external customer in releasing new products. May participate in the selection, development and evaluation in personnel to ensure the efficient operation of the function. Additionally, the Manufacturing Engineer will provide high level technical expertise to a project or program such as planning, task layouts, technical calculations, design and analysis functions, technical report writing, presentations and other engineering functions as required.

Essential Responsibilities May Include:
